Help to Chart the Future of Lake Accotink Park

The public is invited to join in the process for revising Lake Accotink Park's master plan by attending an informational meeting at Kings Glen Elementary School on May 16, 2016. The meeting will be held from 7 to 8:30 p.m. and is the second meeting in this public process which began earlier this month. This meeting will focus primarily on the sustainability of Lake Accotink.

For the past year, the Fairfax County Park Authority has been studying ways to make Lake Accotink Park more environmentally and financially sustainable. Results of that study will be presented at the meeting, and community members are invited to join the discussion about the park's future.

On March 14, the Park Authority hosted an open house community meeting to introduce the master plan revision project, get public input, and share a wealth of information about Lake Accotink Park. Nearly 100 people attended the event, and the presentation from that evening has been posted to the [project webpage](#) for those who could not attend.
