Writer Michael Bohn Leads Discussion on Historic Homes in Mt. Vernon

Discover old buildings in our midst with fascinating stories to tell. Join author Michael K. Bohn on Saturday, October 1, 2016 at 1 p.m. at the Norma Hoffman Visitor Center in Huntley Meadows Park for a photo tour of the history-rich Mount Vernon community. As shown in Bohn's book, *Mount Vernon Revisited*, the Mount Vernon community is more than George Washington and his fabled home. From Woodlawn and Quakers to Woodhouse and the George Washington Air Junction, Bohn will reveal Mount Vernon's intriguing history as reflected in photographs, maps and other images he has collected. A guided tour of the Historic Huntley house and grounds will follow Bohn's presentation. Be sure to save the date!

Author Bohn is a nationally syndicated writer and an expert on Mount Vernon area history. He was a career naval intelligence officer for 20 years. During the second Reagan administration, he served as director of the White House Situation Room. Now a freelance writer, he is the author of *Mount Vernon Revisited* (2014), *Heroes & Ballyhoo: How the Golden Age of the 1920s Transformed American Sports* (2010) and *Presidents in Crisis: Tough Decisions Inside the White House from Truman to Obama* (2015).
