Toe-tapping Music Returns to Frying Pan with New Bluegrass Barn Series

Joe Mullins and the Radio Ramblers will kick off the new season of Frying Pan Farm Park’s popular Bluegrass Barn concert series on October 2, 2016.

These performers make each song their own while respecting the tradition that lies at the heart of bluegrass. Their exciting stage shows and popular recordings keep them in demand, performing at high-profile venues such as Bluegrass Nights at the Ryman and the Grand Ole Opry. Doors for the performance in the Visitor Center will open at 6 p.m. Show time is 7 p.m.

The concert series, which runs through April, is sponsored Vienna Hardwoods, Eastman Guitars and Mandolins, and Arts Herndon in cooperation with the Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park and the Fairfax County Park Authority. Other artists this year will include Bill Emerson & Sweet Dixie, April Verch, Chris Henry & Hard Core Grass, Sweet Yonder, Steve Gulley & New Pinnacle, and The Box Cars. Food and drinks, including beer and wine, are available for purchase at the concerts. Tickets are \$18 in advance and \$20 at the door.

You can save \$4 per ticket and support the Bluegrass Barn by becoming a season pass holder. Not sure you can make all the shows? No problem. The passes may be transferred to a guest of your choice if you cannot attend. A season pass costs just \$112 and includes admission to all shows, and provides prime reserved seating. Something new this season – group ticket sales. Bring your friends, neighbors, club, extended family or group of any kind and save a little money. With a group of 10 or more, the price per ticket drops to \$16. Group sales must be completed during normal business hours, which are 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
