## Chase Those Winter Blahs Away with Bluegrass at Frying Pan

Escape the winter's cold with the heartwarming sounds of bluegrass music at Frying Pan Farm Park. Circa Blue and Goldheart will be providing the entertainment this month as the Bluegrass Barn Series of performances continues.

Circa Blue will be all "about" bluegrass on Sunday evening, January 17, 2016. The group is not completely traditional but not totally contemporary either. Circa Blue performs original material and adapts other popular songs using their own arrangements. Tight vocal harmonies, clean instrumentation, and creative arrangements keep audiences tapping their toes and dancing in their seats. Steve Harris founded the band in 2010, plays guitar, and sings lead and harmony vocals. Completing this engaging band are Garrett Wren on mandolin, Ashley Stewart on bass, Matt Hickman on the banjo, and Malia Furtado on the fiddle.

Goldheart will take the stage on Sunday, January 31. The three youthful but talented Gold sisters -- Tori, Jocey, and Shelby -- bring audiences their original songs and beautiful "sister harmonies" supported by their capable instrumental work. Tori plays mandolin, Jocey plays guitar and Shelby, a well-regarded recording session artist, plays fiddle. The sisters are touring in support of their new CD release, "Places I've Been."

Performances are held indoors at the park's visitor center. Food and drinks, including beer and wine, are available for purchase. Doors open for both shows at 6 p.m., and the music starts at 7 p.m. Tickets are \$18 in advance or \$20 at the door.
