Feed Animals or Go Birding in Fairfax Parks

Search for worms and insects and watch the animals feast at Ellanor C. Lawrence Park on **Feeding Day** on Saturday, March 12, 2016. Join a naturalist and youth volunteers at the park who will demonstrate how site display animals are fed, and give them a hand with feeding time. You'll also get to make a birdfeeder to take home. The program from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. is for participants age two to adult. The cost is \$6 per person, and children must be accompanied by a registered adult.

Wake the kids up early on Sunday, March 13, and take them to Huntley Meadows Park for a **Birding for Beginners** class. The focus of this month's program is waterfowl. Learn about ducks, geese and other birds that take to the water and gain some basic identification skills. Birding for Beginners begins with an indoor discussion before moving outdoors. The program runs from 8 to 11 a.m. and is designed for participants age 12 to adult. The cost is \$8 per person. Children age 12 to 16 must be accompanied by a registered adult.
