See What's Stirring Underfoot in the Forest at Scott's Run

Look down and learn to appreciate what's happening right under your nose as you explore the forest floor with a naturalist at Scott's Run Nature Preserve.

With your guide from Riverbend Park, you will explore life in the leaf litter, uncover the diversity of soil organisms in the forest, and learn about the crucial role invertebrates play in helping the forest stay healthy. The hike on Sunday, June 26, 2016, is designed for participants age eight to adult and runs from 10 to 11:30 a.m. The cost is \$8 per person.

Meet at Scott's Run Nature Preserve's west parking lot, but plan ahead. There are no facilities at Scott's Run.
