Explore Local History This Summer at Camp

History Explorers Camp is a week-long adventure from July 11 - 15, experiencing local history through interactive tours and activities at historic sites that illustrate different times in our nation's history. At Huntley Meadows, learn about the Powhatans' lives and then travel to Historic Huntley to see how the house was built in the 1800s. We will travel to Sully Historic Site, start the day cooking in the 18th-century kitchen and in the afternoon learn about the lives of the enslaved African Americans who lived there. At Brentsville Courthouse learn about historic farming and bring order to a courtroom. At Ben Lomond Historic Site, drill like a soldier and learn about Civil War medical practices. Finally, we will be exploring the rich history of Ellanor C. Lawrence Park, cooking over a campfire, doing farm chores and making ice cream. Van transportation included.
