## Bill Emerson & Sweet Dixie Perform in Bluegrass Barn Series at Frying Pan

Hometown musician Bill Emerson & Sweet Dixie will perform Sunday, October 30, 2016, as the Bluegrass Barn Series continues at Frying Pan Farm Park. Relax in the park visitor center and enjoy an evening of country music.

Emerson started singing and playing the banjo in 1953 and went on to become a founder of the world famous Country Gentlemen. He's played with Jimmy Martin's great Sunny Mountain Boys, Red Allen and Emerson & Waldron, and he became the leader of the Navy's Country Current band. Doors for the show open at 6 p.m., and show time is 7 p.m. Food and drinks, including beer and wine, are available for purchase.

Tickets for the performance are \$18 in advance and \$20 at the door. If you want to save a little money, get a group together. With a group of 10 or more, you pay only \$16 per ticket. Group sales must be completed during normal business hours, which are 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The concert series, which runs through April, is sponsored by Vienna Hardwoods, Eastman Guitars and Mandolins, and Arts Herndon in cooperation with the Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park and the Fairfax County Park Authority.
